ORDINANCE NO. 5003

AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST THE PROPERTIES SPECIFICALLY BENEFITTED BY SANITARY SEWER LINES AND WATERLINES FOR WL-90-5/SS-90-6, ALLEN LANE UTILITIES EXTENSION L.I.D., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

- 1. The sanitary sewer lines and waterlines assessments as referred to in this ordinance and previous resolutions and ordinances are for the sanitary sewer lines and waterlines to serve WL-90-5/SS-90-6, Allen Lane Utilities Extension L.I.D..
- 2. Preliminary resolutions and ordinances prescribing the manner and extent of the improvements are set forth in Resolutions Nos. 3026, 3014, 3009, 2997, 2989, ARA 1991-1.
- 3. The assessments set forth in the following ordinance are based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer in compliance with Albany Municipal Code, Section 15.04.110.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The costs of the sanitary sewer lines and waterlines to serve WL-90-5/SS-90-6, Allen Lane Utilities Extension L.I.D., are as follows:

Section 4: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, safety, and health of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
