AN ORDINANCE TO DETERMINE THE ASSESSMENTS AGAINST THE PROPERTIES SPECIFICALLY BENEFITTED BY STREET AND UTILITIES FOR ST-91-4, WAVERLY DRIVE EXTENSION/COLUMBUS STREET IMPROVEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS:

- 1. The assessable street and utilities assessments as referred to in this ordinance and previous resolutions and ordinances are for the street and utilities to serve ST-91-4, Waverly Drive Extension/Columbus Street Improvement.
- 2. Preliminary resolutions and ordinances prescribing the manner and extent of the improvements are set forth in Resolutions Nos. 3148, 3157, 3161, and 3365.
- 3. The assessments set forth in the following ordinance are based upon the request and recommendation of the City Engineer in compliance with Albany Municipal Code, Section 15.04.110.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
