AN ORDINANCE DECLARING A STREET NAME AS LISTED BELOW FOR THE PUBLIC ROAD DEDICATED IN LINN COUNTY AND ACCEPTED BY THE ALBANY CITY COUNCIL BY RESOLUTION NO. 3694 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY (PLANNING CASE FILES CU-15-95 AND SR-04-96).

WHEREAS, a public street right-of-way was dedicated as a result of an accessway for a recreational vehicle park which aligns with the new Linn County Fair and Expo Center entrance road; and

WHEREAS, the developers of the Recreational Vehicle Park and the Linn County Board of Commissioners requested the street name following the process identified in Section 12.640 of the Revised Albany Development Code.

WHEREAS, staff determined that the street name was appropriate; and

WHEREAS, notices of the decision will be mailed to affected parties by September 30, 1996, as required by Section 12.630(3a) of the revised Albany Development Code; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council on September 25, 1996, voted to approve the proposed street name at the request of staff; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: That public road lying north of the intersection of Knox Butte Road (County Road No. CR 7) with the entrance road to the new Linn County Fair and Expo Center (as shown on attached Exhibit A) is hereby known as EXPO PARKWAY NE.
- Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of this city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
