RESOLUTION NO. 21

Resolution of Intention to Improve.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, deems it expedient and proposes to improve the following streets, to-wit;

Twelfth Street from Vine Street to Washington Street; in the City of Albany, Oregon, in the following manner, to-wit:

- 1. Grading to proper sub-grade.
- 2. Placing necessary base material.
- 3. Installing curbs and gutters where necessary.
- 4. Installing proper drainage system.
- 5. Paving with primat surface.

That said improvements be aade in accordance with law and with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Harold W. Poling, Engineer, which said plans, specifications and estimates wereefiled in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, on the 10th day of June, 1948.

The cost of improving the intersections of said street above described and where required by said plans and specifications shall be at the expense of the City of Albany and shall be paid for out of the general fund of saud City; the street, as hereinabove described, shall be assessed on and against the real property adjacent thereto and especially and particularly benefitted thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City.

The Engineer's estimates of the total probable cost of making the improvements of said portions of the street hereinabove described is the aggregate sum of \$5,347.00, and the Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of said improvements to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portions of said street hereinabove described is the sum of \$5.157.00.

The Council therefore hereby ascertains and determines the total probable cost of making said improvement of said portions of said street to be the aggregate sum of \$5,347.00.

The Council further ascertains and determines the total probable cost of making said improvements to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent thereto to be the sum of \$5,157.00.

The plans, specifications and estimates of Harold W. Poling, Engineer, for the improvement of those portions of streets as hereinabove described are hereby approved and adopted, said plans, specifications and estimates now being on file in the office of the Recorder of said City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and he is hereby ordered and directed to give notive of said proposed improvements of said portions of said streets, as hereinabove described, for the time and in the manner provided by law and the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon.
