WHEREAS heretofore petition was presented to the City Council of Albany, Oregon, requesting that the said Council consider the decontrol of rents as provided by the statutes of the United States of America;

WHEREAS, based upon such petition, a public hearing was held on August 10, 1949 at the regular meeting of the Council at the City Hall and notice was first given on July 28, 1949 and notice continued to be given to the public of the intention of the Council to hear all persons who might be interested in respect to the proposed decontrol at such time and place,

WHEREAS such meeting was held and all persons who wished to be heard were heard, and it appearing to the Council from the information submitted at the hearing that there no longer exists such a shortage in rental housing accommodations as to require rent control within the limits of the City of Albany and the necessity for the continuance of the control of rental units no longer exists,

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon do recommend that the City of Albany be removed as an area under rent control and that such decontrol shall be accomplished at the earliest time possible.
