RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO IMPROVE

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon deems it expedient and proposes to improve PENN AVENUE beginning at the south side of Twelfth Avenue to the south end of the street and centered on the present center of the dedicated street, and also that a turn-around be included at the dead-end of the said street, by

> Installing curbs and gutters Grading for a roadway twenty feet wide and centered on the present center of the dedicated street

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates were filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on 4-2.6-5.

The cost of improving the said streets above described and where required by said plans and specifications shall be at the expense of the City of Albany and shall be paid for out of the general fund of said City, the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement of said streets above described shall be assessed on and against the real property adjacent thereto and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the Charter of said City.

The estimate of the total probable cost of the improvement of said streets above named is the sum of ψ , and the estimate of the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent thereto and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of φ

The plans, specifications and estimates presented by the City Manager for the improvement of said streets above nambed are hereby approved and adopted, said plans, specifications and estimates now being on file in the office of the Recorder of said City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Recorder of the City of Albany be and he is hereby ordered and directed to give notice of said proposed improvement of said streets above named, as hereinbefore provided, for the time and in the manner as provided by law and the Charter of the City of Albany.
