THERE SHALL BE INITIATED SUCH PROCEEDINGS AS ARE NECESSARY TO VACATE
SEVENTH AVENUE FROM THE EAST LINE OF RAILROAD STREET TO THE WEST
LINE OF JACKSON STREET BEING THE STREET BETWEEN BLOCKS 16 AND 17,
HACKLEMAN'S 2ND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ALBANY.

The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to give notice of a public hearing on the proposed said vacation of the street as above described to be held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall on the 27th day of May, 1953, at the hour of 7:15 o'clock P.M., P.S.T. by publication notice thereof once a week for four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Albany and by posting notice thereof at each end of the proposed vacation and at two places within the area vacated within five days of first publication date. Said notice to set forth the time, place and purpose of the said hearing and to contain a description of street proposed to be vacated.

The above proposed vacation is for the purpose of health and safety and to provide additional park facilities to the City of Albany and will be used in conjunction with the swimming pool and Swanson field which lay adjacent to the said proposed vacation.
