

RESOLUTION NO. 272

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City of Albany hold in its custody funds posted as bail against alleged violations of City Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, in order to provide proper control of such funds and to provide for a system of accounting for the receipt and disbursement of such funds, and

WHEREAS, such funds are handled by the Albany Police Department and are subject to control by the Recorder of the City of Albany in the performance of his duties pertaining to the Albany Recorder's Court, and

WHEREAS a "Municipal Court Account" has been established at the U. S. National Bank, Albany Branch, in order to facilitate the handling of such funds, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Recorder for the City of Albany be and he hereby is appointed custodian of the funds deposited to the Municipal Court Account hereinabove described by the Albany Police Department and that the Recorder and an employee of the Albany Police Department to be designated by the City Manager hereby are authorized and empowered to sign checks against said account for the purpose of refunding bail to the person depositing the same or upon order of the Recorder's Court, of paying said funds to the General Fund of the City of Albany, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Recorder be required to furnish a report on the receipt and disbursement of such funds at such time as the Council or City Manager of said City may require and that a record be kept of the receipt and disbursement of such funds and that such record be available to the said Council or City Manager at any time.
