RESOLUTION NO. 403 City of Albany, Oregon

WHEREAS, there has been introduced in the Senate of the Forty-Ninth Legislative Assembly, Regular Session, State of Oregon, Senate Bill Number 333 relating to an apportionment of taxes levied for market road purposes including new provisions thereunder; and,

WHEREAS, under the present statutes of the State of Oregon, counties may levy taxes against all property in the County for market road purposes and all monies so levied and collected by the County can be used for roads outside of the corporate limits of Cities; and,

WHEREAS, the municipal corporations in the State are required to maintain roads within their corporate limits and do not receive benefit from monies collected by the County for market road purposes, although they are subject to tax levies on property within the City, and,

WHEREAS, Senate Bill Number 333 will provide for equitable distribution of road district levies in the County between county roads and roads within the corporate limits of cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, that the unanimous support of this body be given to passage of Senate Bill Number 333.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the members of the legislature representing Linn County and to appropriate committees of the Forty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.
