<u>RESOLUTION NO. 490</u>

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to establish a policy concerning certain expenditures to be made during the fiscal year 1958-59, and

WHEREAS, due consideration has been given by the members of the Council to the necessity of certain items as proposed in the Budget as adopted, and

WHEREAS, it is determined that the salary classification of Parks Foreman should be changed to provide for extra duties so that if deemed advisable by the City Administration appropriate increases may be made, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Council that no salary increase for the City Attorney shall exceed fifty dollars per month (\$50.00); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL of the City of Albany that as a matter of policy of the City Council, the City Manager shall consider the following matters in making expenditures authorized under the 1958-59 Budget of the City of Albany:

- a) The pay range number of the Parks Foreman shall be changed from 25 to 28;
- b) Meetings and organizations authorized under the Fire Department shall not exceed \$200.00;
- c) The City Attorney shall not be granted a salary increase in excess of \$50.00 per month in any one year;
- d) No money shall be allowed under Building Inspection for a telephone or for meetings and organizations;
- e) The Engineering Department shall not be allowed any money for radios and the total amount to be spent by the Department for new equipment shall not exceed \$580.00;
- f) Meetings and organizations authorized under the Police Department shall not exceed \$1,100.00.
