

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 2753 requires that all Parking Meter Zones shall be established by resolution and shall specify the lawful time limit and amount of coin to be deposited, and

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Albany established the Parking Meter Zones by the passage of Resolution No. 446, and

WHEREAS the Parking Commission after conducting an investigation have made recommendations pertaining to the removal and placement of meters which would alter the areas designated in Resolution No. 446, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that Resolution No. 446 be amended in order to include the following revisions:

- Section 1:
- A. Remove all parking meters on Washington Street except the first two metered spaces on the East side of Washington Street South of First Avenue and the first two metered spaces on the East side of Washington Street South of Second Avenue.
  - B. Install one twelve minute meter on the north side of Third Avenue next to Washington Street.
  - C. With the exception of the twelve minute meter listed above, install 4 hour meters at a reduced rate on the north side of Third Avenue between Washington and Ferry Streets.
  - D. Install three 2 hour meters in front of the Library Building on Ferry Street between Third Avenue and the alley.
  - E. Mark the east side of Ferry Street between Third and Fourth Avenues to show parking spaces.
  - F. Install two 2 hour meters in the first two parking spaces south of Third Avenue on the west side of Ellsworth Street.
  - G. Install four hour meters at a reduced rate on both sides of Fourth Avenue between Ellsworth and Ferry Streets.

Section 2: Two hour meters shall allow one hour parking upon deposit of five cents (5¢) in coin.

Section 3: Four hour meters at a reduced rate shall allow two hour parking upon deposit of five cents (5¢) in coin.
