RESOLUTION NO. 680

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2753 requires that all Parking Meter Zones shall be established by resolution and shall specify the lawful time limit and the amount of coin to be deposited, and

WHEREAS the Police Department has recommended that a taxi stand be eliminated and a two-hour parking meter be installed in said space, and

WHEREAS it has been recommended by the Police Department that a parking meter space be removed to allow space for a drive-way to off-street parking area, and it is deemed to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Albany, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the parking meter space described as the sixth space west from the corner of Broadalbin Street on the north side of Third Avenue be and the same is hereby removed and said space shall be used as an access to off-street parking area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that a taxi stand be removed and a two-hour parking meter be installed in the following location:

The third space south from the corner of First Avenue on the West side of Broadalbin Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the two-hour meter shall allow one-hour parking upon deposit of five cents (5¢) in coin and twelve minute parking upon deposit of one cent (1¢) in coin.
