WHEREAS, US Highway 20 between Albany and the Oregon Coast is a major traffic carrier for tourists and is in need of extensive repairs and improvements, and



RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that action be taken by the State Legislature directing the repair and improvement of US Highway 20 between Albany and Newport. Be it further

RESOLVED that the State of Oregon gasoline tax be increased by one cent per gallon with the revenue to be used for the making of needed highway improvements and repairs.
