RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ROAD WIDTH FOR QUEEN AVENUE AND DIRECTING PACIFIC POWER AND LIGHT TO CONSTRUCT BRIDGE AND SIDEWALK OVER VINE STREET CANAL.

WHEREAS, the safety of the citizens of the City of Albany requires that Queen Avenue in the vicinity of Vine Street be widened so that there shall be a 42 foot street width from curb to curb and five (5) foot wide sidewalks on each side of the roadway for pedestrians use; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 366 as amended requires Pacific Power and Light Company, as franchisee to make necessary construction when directed to do so by the Council for the City of Albany; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY that Queen Avenue at Vine Street be widened so that the roadway shall be 42 feet from curb to curb and that in addition thereto there shall be sidewalks five (5) feet in width adjoining each curb.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Pacific Power and Light Company be directed to construct a bridge over the Albany canal on Vine Street so that the paved surface of the road shall be 42 feet in width from curb to curb and adjoining on each side of the curb there shall be a five (5) foot sidewalk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Pacific Power and Light Company be directed to undertake the construction at the earliest possible date.
