ADOPTION OF ENGINEER'S REPORT, AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE EASEMENTS, TO OBTAIN BIDS AND TO ISSUE WARRANTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 18TH AVENUE FROM MAPLE STREET TO PACIFIC BOULEVARD

BE IT RESOLVED that the report of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 13th day of May, 1966, concerning the following street improvement:

18TH AVENUE FROM MAPLE STREET TO PACIFIC BOULEVARD be and the same is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction of said project as required by law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to make, issue and negotiate General Obligation Warrants for the performance of said improvement bearing interest at 4% per annum and constituting General Obligations of the City of Albany. The terms and conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 298.510.
