RESOLUTION NO. 1028

WHEREAS, Notice of a proposal by the City to adjust fire protection rates charged by the City to the Albany Rural Fire Protection District was given the Secretary of the District in April of 1967, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District have been unable to agree to such request because of recent failure of a ballot measure to authorize a sufficient tax levy to permit such an agreement, and

WHEREAS, the fire protection agreement current between the City and the District may be no longer effective after July 1, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District has by letter indicated intention to hold another election at which time the voters within the district will be requested to approve a tax levy in amount sufficient to permit continuation of the fire protection contract after July 1, 1967, and

WHEREAS, the Board has stated that such election will be likely to be held not later than July 17, 1967, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council hereby extends the fire protection contract with the Albany Rural Fire Protection District beyound July 1, 1967 to July 26, 1967 in order to provide the time requested by the district and to provide sufficient time for the Board to act upon the City's request.
