

RESOLUTION NO. 1100

ADOPTION OF ENGINEER'S REPORTS, AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE EASEMENTS, TO OBTAIN BIDS, AND TO ISSUE WARRANTES FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF SIDEWALKS


BE IT RESOLVED that the report of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder the 10th day of May, 1968, concerning sidewalk improvements as follows:

34th Ave. (Pine to approx. Lafayette St. - North side only	Along the property line
Tudor Way (34th Ave. to 31st Ave.)	Both sides Along the property line
33rd Ave. (Tudor Way to Oak St.)	Both sides Along the property line

be and the same is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and the City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction of said projects as required by law, and authorize the Mayor and the City Recorder to make, issue and negotiate General Obligation Improvement Warrants for the performance of the said improvements being interest at 4% per annum and constituting General Obligations of the City of Albany. The terms and conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.
