be and the same is hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and the City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction said projects as required by law, and authorize the Mayor and the City Recorder to make, issue and negotiate General Obligation Improvement Warrants for the performance of the said improvements bearing interest at 4% per annum and constituting General Obligations of the City of Albany. The terms and conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.
