BE IT RESOLVED, that the abstract of votes of the Council of the City of Albany, as to the ballots cast in the Special Election, held April 3, 1969, be and the same is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the ballots cast on the measure in the Special Election of the City of Albany of April 3, 1969, are as follows:

Referred to the legal voters of the City of Albany by the City Council:

Shall the City of Albany levy a special continuing five (5) year tax levy not to exceed \$318,091.00 p er year outside the 6% limitation as provided in the Oregon Constitution, beginning with the tax year 1969-70 to provide funds for mosquito control, salaries and payroll taxes, park maintenance, acquisition of property for parks and development thereof, railroad crossing protection, traffic signal construction, and bridge construction?

The rate of levy deemed necessary to raise the above amount is estimated as follows:

For 1969-70, the sum of \$2.81 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1970-71, the sum of \$2.78 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1971-72, the sum of \$2.68 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1972-73, the sum of \$2.57 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city;

For 1973-74, the sum of \$2.52 per \$1,000.00 of true cash value of taxable property within the city;'
