ADOPTION OF ENGINEER'S REPORTS, AUTHORIZATION TO SECURE EASEMENTS, TO OBTAIN BIDS, AND TO ISSUE WARRANTS FOR SOUTH RESIDENTIAL STORM SEWER LATERAL EXTENSION B-1

BE IT RESOLVED, that the reports of the City Engineer filed with the City Recorder on the 20th day of February, 1970, concerning a storm sewer to drain most of the area located between 34th Avenue and the Albany-Santiam Canal and between Thurston Street and Oak Street, included in the area will be the proposed D. F. Lentz Subdivision, proposed Jeffery 4th Addition and lots adjacent to 38th Avenue between Hill Street and Oak Street which drains towards Hill, to be designated as:

South Residential Storm Sewer Lateral Extension B-1

be and the same are hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction of said projects as required by law, and authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to make, issue and negotiate General Obligation Improvement Warrants for the performance of said improvements bearing interest at 6% per annum and constituting General Obligations of the City of Albany. The terms and conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.
