WHEREAS, the Albany Safety Council and the Albany Parking Commission have met and recommend the following,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that Grand Prairie Road from Geary to Waverly Drive be posted for 40 mph; Queen Avenue, Geary to Waverly Drive be posted for 40 mph; Waverly Drive, Santiam to Queen be posted for 40 mph; Waverly Drive, Queen to Grand Prairie Road be posted for 30 mph; and 34th Avenue, Pacific Blvd. to Waverly Drive be posted for 35 mph; and

BE IT RESOLVED that 9th Avenue be improved from Geary to Hill Street because of necessary fire access to local businesses in that area and that in the interim parking be eliminated on 9th Avenue between Geary and Warner Street, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that parking be eliminated for 150 feet on Pacific Boulevard on the southeast corner of 34th and Pacific Blvd. because of a sight distance problem, and

BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that parking be allowed on the south side of 3rd Avenue between Jackson and Railroad except for a 20' section which begins 127' from the SW corner of 3rd and Jackson; and on the west side of Jackson between 3rd and 4th Avenue; and on the north side of 4th Avenue between Railroad and Jackson Streets except for a 20' section which begins 89' from the northwest corner of 4th and Jackson Streets; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that parking be allowed on the east side of Railroad Street between 3rd and 4th Avenues except for a section which begins at the SE corner of 3rd and Railroad and extends for 33' and except for a 20' section which begins 102 feet from the SE corner of 3rd and Railroad.
