## RESOLUTION NO. 1585

WHEREAS, the City of Albany by and through its agent has attempted to acquire property hereinafter described as and for storm drainage purposes and has been unable to acquire the same and in order to acquire such land condemnation proceedings will have to be taken; be it

RESOLVED that the City of Albany initiate a complaint for the

condemnation of the following described land: a strip of land 40 feet in width, the centerline of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is N 1°30' W 40.0 feet and N 89°10' W 308.85 feet from the Southeast corner of Abraham Hackleman D.L.C. #62 in Towhship 11 South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian in Linn County, Oregon, said point lying on the north right-of-way line of Queen Avenue;

Thence along the arc of a 632.32 foot radius curve to the right a distance of 175.0 feet (long chord of curve bears N  $46^{\circ}29^{\circ}30^{\circ}$  W 244.58 feet) except that portion of the above described property deeded as Periwinkle Creek right-of-way as recorded in MF 65 Page 286, Linn County Deed Records.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to sign and verify the petition and any and all papers which may be required in said proceedings, and be it further

RESOLVED that the city attorney be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to commence and conduct any and all proceedings necessary for the condemnation of such lands.
