RESOLUTION NO. 1656

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Parking Commission and the City of Albany Safety Council have met for study and do recommend the following to the City Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that parking be prohibited on the west side of Waverly Drive between 8th Avenue and Santiam Highway and that the shoulder on the east side of the street be tiled where the open ditch now exists and the entire side be graveled where necessary; and

that the manlift and ladder at the Oak Creek Pump Station is a definite safety hazard and should be replaced by the most economical way feasible and which would comply with all federal and state safety regulations; and

that parking be prohibited 25 feet on the mortheast and southeast corners of both Bain and Lansing Streets and 10 feet on either side of the crosswalk on the west side of Bain Street; and

that a twenty-minute loading zone for 50 feet in length be established in front of the Albany Clinic on Seventh Avenue just east of the westerly driveway of the clinic parking lot; and

that parking be prohibited for one parking space on each side of the alley on the west side of Ellsworth between Second and Third Avenue; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Albany that any action necessary to collect the parking assessment fees from those merchants who have not paid be taken.
