WHEREAS, the Albany Parking and Safety Commission has met for study on the following safety items and does recommend that the proposed action be adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the following recommendations be approved:

- 1) That the existing stop signs stopping 6th Avenue at Ferry Street be removed and relocated on the intersection to stop Ferry Street.
- 2) That parking be prohibited on the north side of Water Avenue between Washington and Ferry Streets except for the first 50 feet west of the west property line of Ferry Street.
- That stop signs be installed on Thurston, Madison, Lafayette, and Jefferson Streets where they intersect with 24th Avenue.
- 4) That "No Parking 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. School Days" zones be established at Oak, Waverly, and South Shore Elementary Schools. The zones should be located adjacent to the main entrances of the schools for a distance of 150 feet along the west side of Oak Street, the east side of Waverly, and the west side of Bain Street.
- 5) That a crosswalk be painted across 4th Avenue on the west side of Columbus Street.
