Project Description:

The Engineering Department has received a petition from some of the property owners in Oak Street between Geary and Queen, requesting sanitary sewer service. The petition represents approximately 25% of the proposed assessment area.

The project will begin at an existing 8-inch sanitary sewer at Oak and Geary and proceed down Oak Street for a distance of approximately 650 feet. Four inch and six inch laterals will be utilized for the adjacent lots.

After several public hearings on this project, the Engineering Department has revised the proposed location of the 8-inch sanitary sewer and will place it in the vicinity of the ditch on the south side of Oak Street. In addition, the assessable area for Tax Lot No. 300 has been decreased.
