The terms of conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.

The Engineering Staff is seeking a resolution from the City Council for authorization to proceed with the construction of new individual house connections in the East Central Sewer Separation area bounded by Lyon and Thurston Street and water to Seventh and Eighth Avenues.

The construction of the new individual house connections will begin as soon as possible; scheduling allowances will have to be made for the construction of the 8" laterals on Phase III and Phase IV sewer projects. Emphasis will be placed on installing new lines to those homes in the seven residential blocks with existing collapsed sewer lines.

The cost for constructing new building sewers varies for each case and is dependant upon accessibility, basements, etc. On the average, \$1,000 per house may be expected.
