

SUBJECT: Proposed Improvements of County Jurisdictional Streets

The City is in the process of improving two streets within the City limits that are still under County jurisdiction. The first street is Geary Street, from the Santiam Highway to Salem Avenue. Community Development funds and property owner assessments will be utilized to finance this project in the summer of 1980 if everything goes according to our plans.

The second street is Salem Avenue between Albany Avenue and Geary Street. Federal Aid, Community Development, and property assessment funds will be utilized to finance the project, and it is scheduled for completion in the summer of 1981.

Since these streets are still under your jurisdiction, the City is requesting that the County also participate in the funding of each project. It is my understanding that County policy has been to participate by paying what the cost of a 2" asphalt overlay would be based on a width of 22 feet times the length of the project. If this is the case, the cost participation for each street is estimated as follows:

<u>Geary Street</u> :	$\frac{22 \text{ feet x } 1200 \text{ feet x } .17 \text{ x } 2.0}{27} = 332 \text{ tons x } \$25.0 = \$8,311.$
Salem Avenue:	$\frac{22 \text{ feet x } 4300 \text{ feet x } .17 \text{ x } 2.0}{27} = 1191 \text{ tons x } 28.0 (1981 \text{ cm})$
