RESOLUTION NO. 2245

WHEREAS, it is appropriate for the City Council to express to the Governor, Senator John Powell, and Representative Mae Yih its views and recommendations on pending legislation which will have an impact upon this City and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council support the concepts and objectives of the following bills and resolutions:

HB2061 which will clarify the enforcement of posted speed limits.

HB2441 which would assist police agencies protect the public from exposure to hazardous situations.

HB2750 which requires the identification of some publicly owned vehicles provided that identification be limited to the owning agency's name, i.e., City of Albany, State of Oregon.

HB2752 which would permit the legislative body to participate in the performance evaluation of employees in executive session.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council opposes the concepts and objectives of the following bills:

HB2521 and HB2896 which would remove the present control of the incorporation of new cities within three miles of an existing city and thus destroy the comprehensive planning required of all cities in the state.

SB60 which would impose a statewide special land use requirement permitting mobile homes in single-family zones when such provisions are correctly a decision for each city and county to make in conjuction with its own comprehensive plan and development code.
