RESOLUTION NO. 2306

WHEREAS, if passed in Oregon's May Primary Election, Ballot Measure 4 will raise the motor vehicle gas tax and the truck weight/mile tax for repairing and improving roads; and

WHEREAS, the gas tax will increase just 1¢ a year for the next three years; and, if passed, the City of Albany will receive approximately \$50,000 each year from each 1¢ increase in the gas tax; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Albany City Council supports the passage of Ballot Measure 4 and urges the citizens of Albany to vote YES on 4 in May.
