BE IT RESOLVED that the engineering reports of the Public Works Director filed with the City Recorder on the 14th day of April, 1982, concerning ST-81-4, Harrison Street between Water Avenue and Bowman Park, be and the same are hereby adopted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to sign agreements on behalf of the City of Albany for the purpose of obtaining easements to construct the said improvements, direct the City Manager to obtain bids for the construction of said projects as required by law, and authorize the Mayor and City Recorder to make, issue, and negotiate General Obligation Improvement Warrants for the performance of said improvements, bearing interest not to exceed 12% per annum, and constituting general obligations of the City of Albany. The terms of conditions of such warrants shall be as provided by ORS 287.502 to 287.510.

SUBJECT: Engineer's Report for ST-81-4, Harrison Street

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT

This project will provide street and storm drain improvements to two blocks of Harrison Street between Water Avenue and Bowman Park. 57.4% of the benefiting property owners have signed a petition for improvement. The recommended street section is 3-1/2" of asphalt concrete on 9" of base rock or 5-1/2" of Portland Cement Concrete on 2" of sand. No right-of-way or easement acquisition is necessary.
