RESOLUTION NO. 2395

WHEREAS, the Oregon Downtown Development Association has been created to assist small cities to develop a public-private effort to revitalize their "mainstreet" areas, and five Oregon cities will be selected to participate in the project in 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the application of the Albany Downtown Association for participation in the 1983 "Mainstreet" Program be endorsed as consistent with the goals of the City of Albany to strengthen and revitalize the central business district including the preservation and rehabilitation of historic buildings.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$44,800 be appropriated from the City's funds to support the activities of the Albany Downtown Association in Fiscal 1983-84, including employment of a full-time manager.
