## RESOLUTION NO. 2425

WHEREAS, the Assessor of Linn County, Oregon, revised the true cash value for the city of Albany on September 1, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the true cash value has a direct effect on the taxes collected by the City of Albany Parks & Recreation Fund; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2397 adopted a budget for the City of Albany for Fiscal Year 1983-84 which included an unadjusted true cash value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution No. 2397 is hereby repealed and the Albany City Council of the City of Albany hereby adopts the budget approved by the Budget Committee for 1983-84 in the total sum of \$17,907,371.
