RESOLUTION NO. 2610

WHEREAS, the Greater Albany Public School District will seek voter approval of a new tax base on May 20 which will not increase school property taxes; and

WHEREAS, without voter approval, the District does not have adequate resources to provide the youth of this community with the education needed to succeed in the modern world; and

WHEREAS, the process of annually seeking voter approval of funds unnecessarily disrupts the educational process, consumes resources which would otherwise be used to improve education and prevents the management of a stable educational program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the voters of the city of Albany be advised that in the judgment of the City Council the approval of a new tax base for the Greater Albany Public School District is of the highest community priority and careful study of the educational needs of the youth of this community and the cost reductions planned to "hold the line" on taxes should be made by each voter before reaching a decision.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that voters seriously consider the proposed levy for operation of the Community Pool which serves not only important recreational and physical fitness needs of all residents, but enables very important basic swimming skills to be taught to the youth of this community.
