

RESOLUTION NO. 2735

WHEREAS, the Albany Traffic Safety Commission has met for study and recommends the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that it does adopt the following recommendations:

1. The Oregon State Speed Control Board's recommendation to establish speed zoning on Oak Street to 35 miles per hour (mph) from 9th Avenue to Queen Avenue and 45 mph from Queen Avenue to Geary Street.
2. The installation of stop signs to provide a four-way stop at the intersection of Jackson Street and 28th Avenue.
3. Establish a two-hour parking zone from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on both sides of 2nd Avenue between Railroad Street and Jackson Street.
