RESOLUTION NO. 2799

WHEREAS the Linn Soil and Water Conservation District has determined a Coordinated Resource Management Plan is necessary to implement the following objectives for those portions of the Calapooia River and Oak Creek Drainages as shown on the attached Exhibit A:

- 1. To improve opportunities for the orderly development of the south Albany and north Tangent urbanizing area.
- 2. To minimize the loss of prime farmland.
- 3. To minimize property damage and potential hazards to public safety which result from flooding.
- 4. To maintain and enhance recreation potential and areas dedicated to open space.
- 5. To improve and where possible enhance riparian vegetation, fish and wildlife habitat, and preserve designated wetlands.
- 6. To facilitate the orderly provision of public facilities and services including the conveyance of storm drainage.
- 7. Enhance water quality through management of non-point and point sources.

WHEREAS the City of Albany finds the above objectives consistent with the Albany Comprehensive Plan and with the need to provide for orderly development opportunities in the south portions of the City Limits and Urban Growth Boundary and to protect property from the detrimental effects of flooding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Members of the City Council of the City of Albany that the City shall be a sponsor of the Calapooia River - Oak Creek Coordinated Resource Management Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that sponsorship does not commit the financial or staff resources of the City of Albany to the development of the Coordinated Resource Management Plan.
