RESOLUTION NO. 2821

A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE COMPETITIVE BIDDING ON THE PURCHASE OF WATER CHLORINATION EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code exempts contracts from competitive bids when there is only one seller or price of a product of the quality required available within a reasonable purchase area, and where the purchase of equipment or supplies for the maintenance, repair, or conversion of existing equipment are required for the efficient utilization of the equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Revised Statutes waive competitive bids on finding that:

- a) It is unlikely that such exemption will encourage favoritism in the awarding of public contracts or substantially diminish competition for public contracts; and
- b) The awarding of public contracts pursuant to the exemption will result in substantial cost savings to the public contracting agency;

and

WHEREAS, Engineered Controlled Products, Inc., is the sole factory-authorized, Oregon supplier for this equipment; and

WHEREAS, the present equipment that the chlorination equipment will be connected to is from the same manufacturer which will eliminate compatibility problems; and

WHEREAS, the City's familiarity with and the operation and maintenance of this equipment in our past experience make this a superior choice from an operational and long-term economy standpoint; and

WHEREAS, the existing equipment presents a safety hazard and replacement of the entire sub-system has been identified in our master plan as a highest priority for upgrading.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council adopts the findings and waives the requirement for competitive bidding for the purchase of water chlorination equipment.
