A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LOCATING AN ADOLESCENT TREATMENT CENTER IN ALBANY.

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council has recognized that substance abuse is the most serious problem affecting our community, particularly our youth; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the following as its number one long term goal: "Achieve a safe, secure, and drug-free Albany"; and

WHEREAS, one of the necessary ingredients for achieving that goal is provision of adolescent treatment facilities in the Albany area; and

WHEREAS, Albany currently lacks residential treatment facilities despite strong local support from law enforcement agencies, schools, the City, County, and local organizations such as Albany Free From Drug Abuse; and

WHEREAS, Milestones Family Recovery Program in Corvallis has demonstrated a strong commitment to the Albany community and the professional skills to provide a quality service; and

WHEREAS, Milestones is seeking competitive grant approval from the State of Oregon for funding of a adolescent treatment center; and

WHEREAS, Milestones has located a suitable residential building in Albany which is capable of supporting an adolescent treatment center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that the City of Albany supports and endorses the location of an adolescent treatment facility within the city of Albany and funding for such by the State of Oregon.
