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EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this <u>54</u> day of <u>UNE</u>, 1991, by and between The United States of America, herein called grantors, and the CITY OF ALBANY, a Municipal corporation, herein called "City."

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the total compensation to be paid by the City, the grantors have this day bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell, convey, and transfer unto the City of Albany, an easement and right-of-way, including the right to enter upon the real property hereinafter described, and to maintain and repair public utilities for the purpose of conveying public utilities services over, across, through, and under the lands hereinafter described, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches and/or trenches for the location of the said public utilities and the further right to remove trees, bushes, under-growth, and other obstructions interfering with the location and maintenance of the said public utilities.

This agreement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The right-of-way hereby granted consists of:

A fifteen foot wide permanent utility easement across that property conveyed to The United States of America in Deed Book 161, Page 421, Linn County Deed Records, more particularly described as follows and as shown on the attached map labeled EXHIBIT A;

A fifteen foot wide strip of land, the centerline of which is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the easterly right-of-way line of Broadway Street which bears South 0°51'00" East 501.17 feet and North 89°09'00" East 30.00 feet from the southwest corner of the Walter Montieth Donation Land Claim No. 55 in section 13, Township 11 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence North 87°17'05" East 220.00 feet to the point of terminus.

ALSO a fifteen foot wide strip of land, the centerline of which is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly right-of-way line of Queen Avenue which bears North $86^{\circ}57'00"$ East 259.00 feet and South $3^{\circ}03'00"$ East 30.00 feet from the southwest corner of the Walter Montieth Donation Land Claim No. 55 in Section 13, Township 11 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence South $3^{\circ}03'00"$ East 10.40 feet; thence South $51^{\circ}27'22"$ West 12.35 feet; thence South $3^{\circ}03'00"$ East 24.50 feet to the point of terminus.

ALSO a fifteen foot wide strip of land, being parallel, adjacent and south of a line which is described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southerly rightof-way line of Queen Avenue which bears North 86°57'00" East 259.00 feet and South 3°03'00" East 30.00 feet from the southeast corner of the Walter Montieth Donation Land Claim No. 55 in Section 13, Township 11 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon; thence North 86°57'00" East

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along said southerly right-of-way line 34.00 feet to the point of terminus.

Contains 0.097 acres, more or less.

- 2. The permanent easement described herein grants to the City, and to its successors, assigns, authorized agents, or contractors, the perpetual right to enter upon said easement at any time that it may see fit, for construction, maintenance, evaluation and/or repair purposes. The city shall contact the U. S. Bureau of Mines and request locates prior to doing maintenance work on the public line; and the city shall repair or replace any items damaged during the work providing they were properly located in the field.
- 3. The easement granted is in consideration of \$1.00 and in further consideration of the public improvements to be placed upon said property and the benefits grantors may obtain therefrom. Nothing herein shall reduce or limit grantors obligation to pay any costs or assessments which may result from the improvements.
- 4. The Grantors do hereby covenant with the City that they are lawfully seized and possessed of the real property above described and that they have a good and lawful right to convey it or any part thereof and that they will forever warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
- 5. Upon performing any maintenance, the City shall return the site to original or better condition.
- 6. Prior to construction of any structure upon the easement, the grantor will reconstruct such portions of the existing public utilities as reasonably required by the City. The grantor shall bear the full cost of such reconstruction. The reconstructed public utilities shall be inspected and approved by the City prior to construction of any structure upon the easement.


