RESOLUTION NO. 3237

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVE FOR OREGON METALLURGICAL CORPORATION UNDER THE ENTERPRISE ZONE ACT OF 1989, WITH CONDITIONS.

WHEREAS, the 1985 State Legislature adopted the Oregon Enterprise Zone Act (the Act) which allows property tax incentives for business expansion in the enterprise zones designated by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, in March 1986, the City Council accepted the Governor's designation of the Albany Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, Oregon Metallurgical Corporation operates a titanium manufacturing plant at 530 34th Avenue SW in the Albany, Oregon Enterprise Zone and has requested property tax incentives available under the provisions of the Enterprise Zone Act to modernize its existing plant and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Albany Enterprise Zone Manager has determined that Oregon Metallurgical Corporation is eligible for the property tax incentives under the provisions of the Enterprise Zone Act, subject to City Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that use of property tax incentives authorized by the Oregon Enterprise Zone Act, ORS 284.245(3)(A)(B)(1989), is approved for Oregon Metallurgical Corporation on the condition that Oregon Metallurgical Corporation satisfies the following requirements:

1. Oregon Metallurgical Corporation shall maintain an annual average of 350 full-time equivalent employees during the tax abatement period.

For the purposes of this resolution, the term "full-time equivalent employee" is defined as follows:

All Oregon Metallurgical Corporation current and future hirees classified as salaried employees, and those production employees eligible for the seniority list based on continuous service provisions as determined by Oregon Metallurgical Corporation's current labor agreements."

2. Oregon Metallurgical Corporation shall commit to retain in Albany its sales and manufacturing facilities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Oregon Metallurgical Corporation shall provide the Albany Enterprise Zone with such information as may be reasonably necessary to review and monitor Oregon Metallurgical Corporation's compliance with the conditions in paragraph 1 above.
