RESOLUTION NO. 3240

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE VEHICLES FOR THE ALBANY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

THE CITY OF ALBANY HEREBY FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Four City of Albany police vehicles are scheduled for replacement and were budgeted for in the Fiscal Year 1992/93 budget.
- 2. The Hillsboro Police wrote a comprehensive Request of Proposal (RFP) for Ford Crown Victoria police vehicles. The bid was awarded to MacKenzie Ford of Hillsboro, Oregon.
- 3. The City of Hillsboro is willing to enter into a ORS 190.010 Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Albany to allow reduced costs for the acquisition of materials and/or services.
- 4. MacKenzie Ford has agreed to sell the City of Albany four Ford Crown Victoria Police vehicles at the same price that was bid to the City of Hillsboro Police Department if the vehicles are ordered before April 15, 1993.
- 5. The purchase of these vehicles without delay and expense inherent in competitive bidding is in the public interest.
- 6. Emergency conditions as set forth above now exist, requiring prompt execution of a contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Albany City Council, acting as the Contract Review Board, hereby declares an emergency and authorizes the execution of a contract without competitive bidding as provided for by the provisions of Section 2.64.060 of the Albany Municipal Code, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council will enter into an ORS 190.010 Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, to purchase four Ford Crown Victoria police vehicles via the recent City of Hillsboro bid award.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Albany purchase four Ford Crown Victoria police vehicles by April 15, 1993, from MacKenzie Ford as specified in the City of Hillsboro bid award.
