

A RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BID REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND COMPLETION OF A VEHICLE EXHAUST SYSTEM AT THE ALBANY FIRE DEPARTMENT STATION 11.

WHEREAS, a portion of a vehicle exhaust system has already been installed at Station 11, and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 1993-94 the City of Albany budget includes an appropriation of \$40,000 for the installation of a vehicle exhaust system, and


WHEREAS, we have already gone out to bid and have installed the first phase of the vehicle exhaust system at Station 11.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council, acting as the Contract Review Board, hereby approves the following findings of fact relating to the vehicle exhaust system:

1. The first phase of the system was bid in 1992-93, awarded to a contractor, and installed at Station 11.
2. The City is interested in having a compatible system in its second and final phase of the system at Station 11.
3. Other brands will not offer improved quality or performance, nor will the lack of bids result in favoritism or substantially diminish competition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albany City Council declares an emergency and authorizes the awarding of the second phase to Alpine Environmental Controls, Inc. who installed phase one of the vehicle exhaust system at the Albany Fire Department Station 11 without competitive bidding as provided for by the provisions of Section 2.64.060 of the Albany Municipal Code.

SUBJECT: Request to Waive Bid Process for Exhaust System

Action Requested:

Approval to waive the bidding process for installation of the second phase of the exhaust system at Station 11.

Discussion:

Funds were budgeted to complete the exhaust system at Station 11. We would like to hire the company who installed the first phase of the system to complete the project at Station 11. Due to this, we wish to waive the bidding process to avoid the possibility of receiving a bid from a competitor whose system would be incompatible with the present system.

Budget Impact:

\$40,000, which is included in the 1993-94 Fire Suppression budget.
