

RESOLUTION NO. 3370

WHEREAS, the property owners of property located adjacent to a portion of City Right-of-Way located north of the intersection of 13th Avenue and Industrial Way have requested a local improvement district be formed to construct a street to City standards within said Right-of-Way; and

WHEREAS, the property owners have requested consideration of City financing of said improvements; and

WHEREAS, the property owners representing 80 percent of the potential assessment apportionment have petitioned for these public improvements and the City Council considers it necessary to require installation of street improvements to be paid for in whole by special assessment; and


WHEREAS, Subsection 15.04.010 of the Albany Municipal Code requires the City Council to declare by resolution that it intends to make said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council intends to make the improvements and hereby directs the City Engineer to make a survey of the improvements and file a written engineer's report with the City Recorder and further directs the Finance Director to prepare a financial investigation report with such reports to be in compliance with AMC Sections 15.040.020 and 15.040.030.
