#### EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 4th day of 1995, by and between A. G. C. International Operating Engineers Local 701 Pension Trust Fund (hereinafter "A. G. C.") AND Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments, herein called Grantors, and the CITY OF ALBANY, a Municipal Corporation, herein called "City."

#### WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the total compensation to be paid by the City, the grantors have this day bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain, sell, convey, and transfer unto the City of Albany, an easement and right-of-way, including the right to enter upon the real property hereinafter described, and to maintain and repair public utilities for the purpose of conveying public utilities services over, across, through, and under the lands hereinafter described, together with the right to excavate and refill ditches and/or trenches for the location of the said public utilities and the further right to remove trees, bushes, under-growth, and other obstructions interfering with the location and maintenance of the said public utilities.

This agreement is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The right-of-way hereby granted consists of:

An easement for a bus shelter lying within Parcel II as conveyed to A. G. C. - International Operating Engineers Local 701 Pension Trust Fund by deed recorded in Volume 574, Page 772, Linn County Microfilm Deed Records, lying in the southwest 1/4 of Section 8, Township 11 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, said easement being more particularly described as follows and as shown on the attached map labeled Exhibit A:

Beginning at a 5/8-inch iron rod at the most northerly-northeast corner of said Parcel II, which is at the intersection of the southerly right-of-ways for Queen Avenue and Oak Street, and lies 718.10 feet South 89° 03' 20" West and 35.00 feet South 0° 56' 40" East from the southwest corner of the Abram Hackleman Donation Land Claim No. 62, said Township and Range; thence leaving said right-of-way intersection South 0° 56' 40" East 10.00 feet; thence South 89° 03' 20" West 20.00 feet; thence North 0° 56' 40" West 10.00 feet to the north line of said Parcel II; thence along said north line North 89° 03' 20" East 20.00 feet to the Point of Beginning.


Containing 200 square feet of land, more or less.

- 2. The permanent easement described herein grants to the City, and to its successors, assigns, authorized agents, or contractors, the perpetual right to enter upon said easement at any time that it may see fit, for construction, maintenance, evaluation and/or repair purposes.
- 3. The easement granted is in consideration of \$1.00 and in further consideration of the public improvements to be placed upon said property and the benefits grantors may obtain therefrom.
- 4. The Grantors do hereby covenant with the City that they are lawfully seized and possessed of the real property above described and that they have a good and lawful right to convey it or any part thereof and that they will forever warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
- 5. Upon performing any maintenance, the City shall return the site to original or better condition.
- 6. No permanent structure shall be constructed on this easement.
