RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING THE CONTRACT AWARD FOR CITY HALL CABLE AND PATCH PANEL WORK FROM COMCRAFT, INC. AND AWARDING SAID CONTRACT TO CHERRY CITY ELECTRIC

WHEREAS, on or about August 28, 1995, bids were open for cable and patch panel work for the City Hall project now under construction. The apparent low bidder was COMCRAFT, INC. The second low bidder was Cherry City Electric; and

WHEREAS, following the bid opening, the City Council of the City of Albany, on September 13, 1995, voted to award the contract to the apparent low bidder, COMCRAFT, INC.; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 22, 1995, COMCRAFT, INC. was notified of the City Council's award/decision and was mailed copies of the contract for signature; and

WHEREAS, Albany Municipal Code and the invitation to bid both advised bidders that they have 10 days within which to enter into a contract with the City of Albany following the date of notice of contract award; and

WHEREAS, COMCRAFT, INC. has failed and refused to enter into the contract tendered by the City of Albany, and has failed and refused to tender the required performance bond.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved as follows:

- 1. The offer to contract with COMCRAFT, INC. for cable and patch panels for city hall construction is hereby withdrawn due to COMCRAFT, INC.'s failure to sign and return the tendered contract and its failure to tender an appropriate performance bond as called for in the bid specifications; and
- 2. The contract offer heretofore extended to COMCRAFT, INC. shall be extended, upon the same terms, to the second low bidder Cherry City Electric.
