## A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, each year the State Historic Preservation Office distributes federal historic preservation funds on a competitive basis, and

WHEREAS, each year the State Historic Preservation Office distributes federal historic preservation funds to Certified Local Governments on a non-competitive basis, and

WHEREAS, a local match of the requested grant funds is required on at least a one-to-one basis, and
WHEREAS, the City of Albany Landmarks Advisory Commission has determined that historic building property owners need better and more information about how to restore/rehabilitate the buildings in the National Register Downtown Historic District and the City needs updated data on the buildings in this district, and

WHEREAS, the Albany Development Code contains regulations that apply to historic properties, and
WHEREAS, receipt of these grant funds would allow the City to hire technical experts for educational workshops and provide funds for educational materials and handouts, and would allow the City to photograph, map and prepare survey forms for the properties in the Downtown Historic District;

WHEREAS, the funds allocated to Certified Local Governments will supplement funding for the City's ongoing historic preservation efforts, and

WHEREAS, this Historic Preservation Fund grant application will request approximately $\$ 6,000$ for edúcation and survey information and for Certified Local Government assistance; and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately $\$ 10,000$ from the Community Development Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Albany City Council does hereby state that completion of the education and survey processes and continued historic preservation activities are priorities and authorize staff to submit an application to the State Historic Preservation Office for funding.
