

RESOLUTION NO. 3848

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BIKEWAY AND WALKWAY GRANT FUNDS AND A COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Bicycle and Pedestrian Program distributes competitive grants for construction projects on local streets; and


WHEREAS, a local match of 20 percent is required; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to construct sidewalks and new curb returns in the vicinity of South Albany High School and to improve bicycle lane striping on Columbus Street; and


WHEREAS, this ODOT grant application will request \$64,000 for construction of transportation improvements to Columbus Street between Grand Prairie Road and the Santiam Canal, and the City of Albany's local match will be approximately \$16,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Department of Transportation for the purpose of constructing transportation improvements to Columbus Street between Grand Prairie Road and the Santiam Canal.
