A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL ASSISTANCE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN GRANT FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO COLUMBUS STREET.

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on August 27, 1997, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Department of Transportation in the amount of \$64,000 for the construction of sidewalks and new curb returns in the vicinity of South Albany High School and the improvement of bike lanes on Columbus Street from Grand Prairie Road to the Santiam Canal; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a local match of 20 percent; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to provide needed pedestrian and bicycle transportation improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this ODOT Grant in the amount of \$64,000 for new sidewalk and bike lanes, approves the City of Albany's local match of \$16,000, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreements and conditions for their acceptance.
