State Revenue Sharing Law, ORS 221.770, requires cities to pass an ordinance or resolution each year stating that they want to receive state revenue sharing money. The law also requires that cities certify that two required public hearings were held.

In order to receive state revenue sharing in 1999-2000, your city <u>must have levied property taxes</u> in the preceding year and:

- 1. Pass an ordinance or resolution approving participation in the program and file a copy of that ordinance with the Internal Service Division before July 31.
- 2. Hold the following hearings on the use of state revenue sharing funds:
 - a) a public hearing before the budget committee to discuss possible uses of the funds;
 - b) a public hearing before the city council on the proposed uses of the funds in relation to the entire budget.
- 3. Certify to the Internal Service Division by completing the form on the back of this letter, before July 31, that these hearings have been held.

The requirements for an Actual Use Report due December 31 of each year and Long Range Fiscal Projections due January 15 were repealed by the 64th Legislative Session. It is no longer necessary for you to file these reports.
