A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FORM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE COX CREEK MULTI-USE PATH.

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on April 26, 2000, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$90,000 for the development of the Cox Creek multi-use path; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a local match of 50 percent; and

WHEREAS, alreceipt of these funds will allow the City to construct a multi-use concrete path, that is handicap accessible, and is approximately 1,700 feet long and 10 feet wide, connecting the recently completed perimeter path around Waverly Lake to the Willamette Riverfront trail at the 164-acre Simpton Park; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$90,000 for development of the Cox Creek multi-use path, approves the City of Albany's local match of \$90,000, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreements and conditions for their acceptance.
