A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE (05-618)

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has established a historic preservation program that includes public education, assistance, and regulatory components.

WHEREAS, the City applied for and has been awarded grant funds from the State Historic Preservation Office to assist in planning and education efforts.

WHEREAS, the required local match of 50 percent is met with in-kind staff time by a planner who spends a portion of her time to overseeing the preservation program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Albany City Council that it does hereby accept a grant in the amount of \$6,000 from the State of Oregon Historic Preservation Office, Parks and Recreation Department, to be used for continuing a Certified Local Government program that includes review of historic alterations, public education, preparing a preservation plan for Albany and request for proposals for a historic context statement, and a mock archaeology dig for Albany elementary school children.
